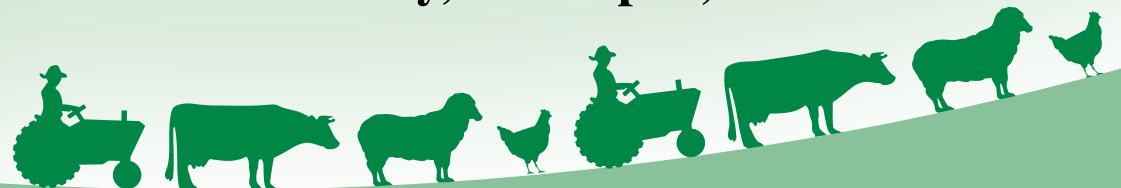

WOODHALL SPA COUNTRY SHOW RULES

Cattle and Sheep Entries

Brucellosis

1. Animals which calve or show evidence of calving while on the showground must be placed in the approved isolation area pending their early removal from the showground.
2. Where an animal calves at full term, and the owner arranges for a blood sample and a vaginal swab to be taken and examined at an approved laboratory, and the Rose Bengal Place Test and microscopical of a smear made from the vaginal test are negative, the animal may return to the show lines at the discretion of the show secretary.
3. Where an animal calves prematurely, or aborts, the show DVO must be informed immediately. The animal must be placed in isolation in approved accommodation, and the full range of samples (including if possible a placenta smear) should be taken. The animal will not be allowed to take further part in the show and once it is fit to travel can be returned home to the registered premises or alternatively retained until the end of the show in isolation and returned with other competing cattle from the same premises.

Cattle: N.B. Animals may be entered for one class only excepting those entered in Class 12 Novice, Class 13 Young Farmer and the Young Handler Classes.

Sheep

Scrapie monitoring

It is a condition of entry that no sheep shall have aborted or lambed within 30 days prior to the show.

Maedi – Visna Accredited Flocks Scheme

Separate areas for loading, unloading, penning and showing will be provided for scheme and non – scheme animals. Exhibitors must take appropriate measures to prevent MV scheme sheep coming into close contact with non – scheme sheep.

Breed Association Registration

All sheep must be eligible for registration with their breed association where applicable.

All Livestock: Bio-Security

It is a condition of entry that exhibitors comply with DEFRA requirements and the shows bio – security plan.

Ownership

Animals must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor on the date of entry.

In the event of 3 entries or less being received classes may be amalgamated.

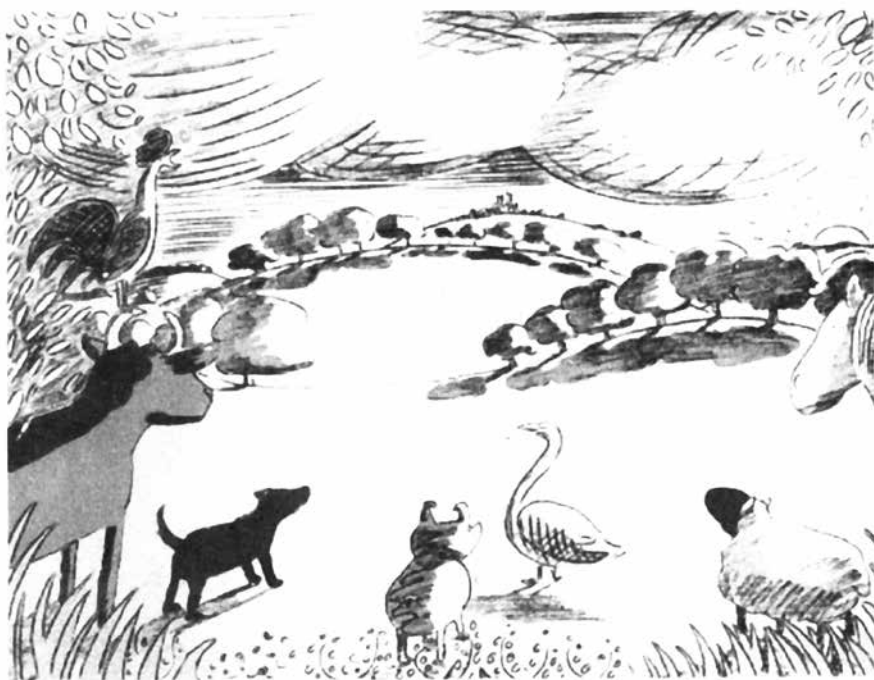

The judge has the authority to ask any exhibitor not having sufficient control of his/her animal to leave the ring.
